Greetings 4 of 4 Dialogue

1st Person: **Halito, chim achukma?**
Hello, [are] you good/well?

2nd Person: **Um achukma hoke! Chishnato?**
I'm doing good/well! And you?

1st Person: **Um achukma hoke/akinli.**
I'm doing good/well or likewise/too.

Word Meaning: **chim** (chehm) = you

chishnato (chish-nah-toh) = and you?

um (ahm) = I'm **halito** (ha-lih-toh) = hello

achukma (ah-chohk-ma) = good/well

hoke (hoh-key) = It is so! (an exclamatory)

akinli (ah-kihn-le) = likewise/too
