Vocabulary: **yihlepa** – to run/scamper

Katimi ho wak vt yihlepa?

Why are the cows running?

Issi yvt sv haklo cha yihlepa tuk.

The deer heard me and scampered.

Word Meaning: **sv** (sah) = me

katimi ho (kah-tih-mih hohn) = why

wak (wahk) = cow

vt (aht) = subject marker

yihlepa (yih-thih-pa) = to run/scamper

issi (ihs-sih) = deer

yvt (yaht) = subject marker

haklo (hahk-loh) = hear

cha (chah) = and

tuk (tohk) = past tense marker
