ishi – to take; to hold; to get

Holisso ma ishi!

Get that book!

Skvlli pa ishi!

Get this money!

Nanta ish ishi tuk?

What did you get?

Note: Underlined vowels are to be pronounced as nasalized.

Word Meaning:

ish (esh) = you **ishi** (i-shi) = to take; to hold; to get; to seize; to embrace; to grab **ma** (mah) = that (shortened from yvmma) **pa** (pah) = this (shortened from ilvppa)
nanta (nahn-tah) = what **skvlli** (skahl-li) = money
holisso (ho-lis-so) = book

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
