himak (he-mak) = now; at this present time

nittak (ne-tahk) = day

himak nittak (he-mak ne-tahk) = today

kapvssa (kah-pah-sah) = cold

chohmi (choh-me) = now

vt (aht) = subject marker

a (ahn) = subject marker

towa (toh-wa) = ball

pisa (pe-sah) = to see

aki (anh-ke) = my father

la (la) = I (changed from -li to -la for future tense)

achi (a-chenh) = future tense

washoha (wah-sho-ha) = play
