Verb: chompa – buy/purchase

Wak nipi chompa pi bunna.

We want to buy beef.

Ilefoka himona chompa li tuk.

I bought new clothes.

Word Meaning:

tuk (tohk) = past tense **pi** (pih) = we

himona (he-moh-na) = new **li** (le) = I

chompa (chohm-pa) = buy/purchase

ilefoka (e-le-fohk-ka) = clothes

wak nipi (wak ni-pe) = beef

bunna (bahn-nah) = want/need
