

Lesson of The Day

Object Marker: yumma – that/those

Ofi chito yumma ipeta li tuk.

I fed that big dog.

Shupo tuklo yumma su bunna.

(When the subject is accompanied by a number it is plural and thus, ‘yumma’ will be translated to be ‘those’.)

I want those two hats.

Word Meaning: **tuk** (tohk) = past tense

ofi (o-fe) = dog

shupo (shah-poh) = hat

su (sah) = I

chito (che-toh) = big/large

yumma (yahm-mah) = that/those

li (le) = I

ipeta (e-pe-tah) = feed

tuklo (tohk-loh) = two

bunna (bahn-nah) = want
