Pronoun: okla – they; people; group

Nanta okla vpa bvnna?

What do they want to eat?

Issi nipi okla vpa bvnna.

They want to eat venison.

Word Meaning:

nanta (nahn-tah) = what

okla (ohk-la) = they; people; group

vpa (ah-pa) = eat (item named)

bvnna (bahn-na) = want/need

issi (is-se) = deer

nipi (ni-pe) = meat

issi nipi (is-se ni-pe) = venison
