Holisso pisa mvt Chikasha.

That student is Chickasaw.

Word Meaning:

Chikasha (Chick-ah-sha) = Chickasaw

sia (se-yah) = I am

vlla (ahl-la) = child

mvt (maht) = subject marker (that)

pisa (peh-sah) = see/look

holisso (hoh-lis-soh) = book/paper

holisso pisa (hoh-lis-soh peh-sah) = student/learner
