Word Meaning:

Hattak ᵛpi Homma (hat-tahk ah-pe hohm-ma) =
Indian/Native American

chia (che-ya) = you are

ohoyo (o-hoh-yoh) = woman

mᵛt (maht) = subject marker (that)

taloa (tah-lo-wah) = sing

ho (hoh) = question marker
