

Lesson of The Day

Verb: vpa – to eat (food item named)

Shukha nipi okla vpa bunna.

They want to eat pork.

Hattak put palvska champuli vpa.

This man is eating cake.

Word Meaning:

shukha nipi (shohk-ha ni-pi) = pork

okla (ohk-la) = they/people

hattak (haht-tahk) = man

vpa (ah-pa) = to eat (food item named)

bunna (bahn-na) = want/need

put (paht) = subject marker (this)

palvska champuli (pa-lahs-ka chahm-poh-lih) = cake
