

# Lesson of The Day

Verb: *impa* – to eat (a meal)

**Holisso pisa yvt impa.**

The students are eating.

**Ulla mvt impa bunna kiyo.**

That child does not want to eat.

Word Meaning:

**holisso pisa** (hoh-lis-soh pi-sah) = student/learner

**yvt** (yaht) = subject marker

**impa** (ehm-pa) = to eat (a meal)

**ulla** (ahl-la) = child

**mvt** (maht) = subject marker (that)

**bunna** (bahn-na) = want/need

**kiyo** (ke-yoh) = not
