Adjective: hohchvffo - hungry

Ulla hohchvffo mvt nukoa.

That hungry child is angry.

Ofi hohchvffo mvt impa.

That hungry dog is eating.

Word Meaning:

vlla (ahl-la) = child

impa (ehm-pa) = to eat

hohchvffo (hoh-chahf-foh) = hungry

mvt (maht) = subject marker (that)

nukoa (noh-koh-wah) = angry

ofi (o-feh) = dog
