Adjective: liteha - dirty

Ampo okchakko pvt liteha.

This blue plate is dirty.

Ilefoka liteha achefa li.

I am washing dirty clothes.

Word Meaning:

li (lih) = I

ampo (ahm-poh) = plate

okchakko (ohk-chahk-koh) = blue

pvt (paht) = subject marker (this)

liteha (lih-te-ha) = dirty

achefa (ah-che-fa) = wash

ilefoka (e-lih-fohk-ka) = clothes
