Adjective: himitta - young

Hattak himitta micha vlla nakni tuklo mvt washoha.

The young man and those two boys are playing.

Abeka apesvchi mvt alikchi himitta apela.

That nurse is helping the young doctor.

Word Meaning:

hattak (haht-tahk) = man **alikchi** (ah-lik-che) = doctor

micha (meh-cha) = and **apela** (ah-peh-la) = help

himitta (he-meht-tah) = young **vlla** (ahl-la) = child

nakni (nahk-ni) = male **tuklo** (tohk-loh) = two

mvt (maht) = subject marker (those/that)

washoha (wah-shoh-ha) = play

abeka apesvchi (ah-be-kah ah-peh-sah-che) = nurse

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
