Adverb of degree: chohmi – sort of/somewhat

Kucha yvt kapvssa chohmi.

It is sort of cold outside.

Ishko ilvppvut homi chohmi.

This drink is somewhat bitter.

Word Meaning:

kucha (ko-cha) = outside

yvt (yaht) = subject marker

kapvssa (kah-pahs-sah) = cold

chohmi (choh-mih) = sort of/somewhat

ishko (esh-koh) = drink

ilvppvut (e-lahp-paht) = subject marker (this)

homi (ho-mih) = bitter/sour

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
