

Lesson of The Day

Indefinite pronoun: nana kia - anything

Nana kia hochefa hinla.

She can read anything.

Aki yvt nana kia ikba hinla.

My father can build anything.

Word Meaning:

nana kia (nah-nah ke-yah) = anything

hochefo (hoh-che-foh) = read/name/call (**hochefo** will change to **hochefa** to accommodate ‘**ahinla.**’)

ahinla (a-hehn-la) = can/may (in the preceding verb before **hinla**, a vowel change must occur to accommodate the ‘**a**’ in **ahinla.**)

aki (ahn-key) = father

yvt (yaht) = subject marker

ikbi (ik-bih) = make/build (**ikbi** changes to **ikba** to accommodate ‘**ahinla.**’)
