## Chim aboha bohli li tuk.

I put/placed/laid it in your room.

## Word Meaning:

```
katimma (ka-tim-ma) = where
ish (esh) = you
bohli (boh-lih) = put/place/lay(s)
tuk (tohk) = past tense marker
chim (chehm) = your
aboha (ah-boh-ha) = room
li (lih)= I
```
