Verb: bohli – put/place/lay(s)(a single item)

Katimma ish bohli tuk?

Where did you *put/place/lay* it?

Chim aboha bohli li tuk.

I *put/placed/laid* it in your room.

Word Meaning:

katimma (ka-tim-ma) = where

ish (esh) = you

bohli (boh-lih) = put/place/lay(s)

tuk (tohk) = past tense marker

chim (chehm) = your

aboha (ah-boh-ha) = room

li (lih)= I
