Word Meaning:

**pinak** (peh-nahk) = food/groceries

**chompa** (chohm-pah) = buy/purchase

**li** (lih) = I

**kiyo** (ke-yoh) = not

**pokni** (pohk-nih) = grandmother

**yvt** (yaht) = subject marker

**tuk** (tohk) = past tense marker

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
