Illimpa ya aiimpa talali.

Set the food on the table.

Akka talali.

Set it down.

Word Meaning:

illimpa (il-lihm-pa) = food/groceries

ya (yahn) = object marker

aiimpa (eye-ehm-pa) = table

talali (tah-la-lih) = put/place/set(s)

akka (ahk-ka) = down
