

# Lesson of The Day

Verb: talohli – put/place/set (plural – 2 or more objects)

**Na pakanli ma aiimpa talohli.**

Set those flowers on the table.

**Ampo liteha ya aiimpa ma talohli.**

Put the dirty dishes on the table.

Word Meaning:

**na pakanli** (na pa-kahn-lih) = flowers

**ma** (mahn) = subject marker (that/those short form)

**aiimpa** (eye-ehm-pa) = table

**talohli** (tah-loh-lih) = put/place/set (plural)

**ampo** (ahm-poh) = plate/dish

**liteha** (lih-tee-ha) = dirty

**ya** (yahn) = object marker
