Noun: ahoponi - kitchen

Pokni yut ahoponi ya binili.

Grandmother is sitting in the kitchen.

Ahoponi ya kashoffi li tuk.

I cleaned the kitchen.

Word Meaning:

pokni (pohk-nih) = grandmother

yut (yaht) – subject marker **ya** (yahn) = object marker

ahoponi (ah-hoh-poh-nih) = kitchen

binili (bih-nih-lih) = sit **li** (lih) = I

tuk (tohk) = past tense marker

kashoffi (kah-shohf-fih) = to clean
