Noun: shukcha – bag/purse

Shukcha lusa yummut pisa achukma.

That black purse is pretty.

Shukcha homma pa aiokpanchi li.

I like this red purse.

Word Meaning:

shukcha (shohk-cha) = bag/purse

lusa (loh-sa) = black **li** (lih) = I

yummut (yahm-maht) = subject marker (that/those)

pisa achukma (peh-sah ah-chohk-ma) = pretty

homma (hohm-ma) = red **pa** (pahn) = object marker

aiokpanchi (ah-yohk-pahn-chih) = to like (something)
