

# Lesson of The Day

Noun: illimpa – food/groceries

**Illimpa ya chompa la hinla.**

I can buy the food.

**Hattak mvt illimpa bunna kiyo.**

That man does not want food.

Word Meaning:

**illimpa** (il-lihm-pa) = food/groceries

**ya** (yahn) = object marker      **kiyo** (key-yoh) = not

**chompa** (chohm-pa) = buy/purchase

**la** (la) = I (**li** changed to **la** to accommodate the future tense ‘**ahinla**’)

**ahinla** (a-hihn-la) = can/may

**hattak** (haht-tahk) = man      **bunna** (bahn-nah) = want/need

**mvt** (maht) = subject marker (that/those)

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
