Noun: ampo – plate/dish

Ampo ilvppvt koa.

This plate is cracked

Ohoyo mvt ampo ya achefa.

That woman is washing the dishes.

Word Meaning:

ampo (ahm-poh) = plate/dish

ilvppvt (e-lahp-paht) = subject marker (this/these)

koa (koh-wah) = crack

ohoyo (o-hoh-yoh) = woman

mvt (maht) = subject marker (that/those)

ya (yahn) = object marker

achefa (ah-che-fah) = (to) wash
