Verb: hlopulli – go through

Kvta hosh holihta ma hlopulli tuk?

Who went through that fence?

Ulla nakni iskitini mvt holihta ma hlopulli tuk.

That small boy went through that fence.

Word Meaning: **hlopulli** (thoh-poh-lih) = go through

kvta (ka-tah) = who **iskitini** (is-kih-ti-nih) = small; little

hosh (hoh-sh) = subject marker

holihta (hoh-lih-tah) = fence

mvt (maht) = subject marker **ma** (mahn) = object marker

tuk (tohk) = past tense marker

vlla (ahl-la) = child **nakni** (nahk-nih) = male

vlla nakni (ahl-la nahk-nih) = boy
