Adverb: ontalaya – setting on

Nanta hosh aiimpa pakna ontalaya?

What is setting on the table?

Na pakanli homma yvt aiimpa pakna ontalaya.

The red flowers are setting on the table.

Word Meaning:

yvt (yaht) = subject marker

hosh (hohsh) = subject marker

aiimpa (eye-ehm-pa) = table

pakna (pahk-nah) = on top of

ontalaya (ohn-tah-lahn-yah) = setting on

na pakanli (nah pah-kahn-lih) = flower/flowers

homma (hohm-ma) = red

nanta (nan-tah) = what
