Verb: kopoli – bite/biting

Ofi mvt kvta ho kopoli tuk?

Who did that dog bite?

Nanta hosh sv kopoli tuk?

What bit me?

Word Meaning: **ofi** (o-feh) = dog

mvt (maht) = subject marker

kvta (kah-tah) = who **sv** (sah) = me

ho (hohn) = question marker

kopoli (koh-poh-lih) = bite/biting

tuk (tohk) = past tense marker

nanta (nahn-tah) = what

hosh (hosh) = subject marker
