

# Lesson of The Day

Verb: aiyv̄la – several arrives

**Hoponi v̄hleha yvt aiyv̄la.**

The cooks have arrived.

**Okla aiyv̄la chī hō?**

Are they going to arrive?

Word Meaning:

**hoponi** (hoh-poh-nih) = cook

**v̄hleha** (ah-theh-ha) = plural

**yvt** (yaht) = subject marker

**aiyv̄la** (eye-yah-lah) = several arrives

**okla** (ohk-lah) = they/people

**hō** (hohn) = question marker

**chī** (chehn) = future tense marker (\*from **achi**)

\*the ‘a’ in ‘**achi**’ is at the end of the word ‘**aiyv̄la**’
