Verb: ittiachi – (to) go (two only)

Ohoyo tuklo mvt tvmaha ittiachi.

Those two women are going to town.

Tuklo pvt ittiachi bunna.

These two want to go.

Word Meaning:

ohoyo (o-hoh-yoh) = women

tuklo (tohk-loh) = two

mvt (math) = subject marker

ittiachi (et-tih-ah-che) = (to) go (two only)

pvt (path) = subject marker

tvmaha (tah-ma-ha) = town

bunna (bahn-nah) = want/need
