Adjective: kashofa – to be clean

Ampo pvt kashofa kiyo.

This plate is not clean.

Aboha mvt kashofa.

That room is clean.

Word Meaning:

ampo (ahm-poh) = plate/dish

pvt (path) = subject marker

kashofa (kah-shoh-fa) = to be clean

kiyo (key-yoh) = not

aboha (ah-boh-ha) = room

mvt (math) = subject marker
