Indirect Object: the nasal form – i – to or for him, her, it

I toksvli li.

I work for him.

Aboha ish i kashoffi ho?

Are you cleaning the room for her?

Word Meaning:

i (ehn) = to or for him, her, it

toksvli (tohk-sah-lih) = work

li (lih) = I

aboha (ah-boh-ha) = room

ish (esh) = you

kashoffi (kah-shohf-fe) = clean

ho (hohn) = question marker
