Fʋni ish p̄isa h̄o?

Do you see the squirrel?

Word Meaning:

fʋni (fah-nih) = squirrel

mʋt (maht) = subject marker (that/those)

impa (ehm-pah) = eat (a meal)

ish (esh) = you

p̄isa (pehn-sah) = see

h̄o (hohn) = question marker
