Indirect Object: the nasal form *hvp̄i* – to or for us (all)

Illimpa hvp̄i chompa bvnna.

He wants to buy food for us (all).

Hattak mvt hvp̄i toksvli.

That man works for us (all).

Word Meaning:

illimpa (il-lihm-pa) = food/groceries

hvp̄i (ha-pehn) = to or for us (all)

chompa (chohm-pah) = buy/purchase

bvnna (bahn-nah) = want/need

hattak (haht-tahk) = man

mvt (maht) = subject marker (that/those)

toksvli (tohk-sah-lih) = work

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
