

Lesson of The Day

Verb: takchi - tie

Shulush i takcha chi ho?

Is she going to tie his shoes?

Ulla mut shulush i takchi tuk.

That child tied his shoe for him.

Word Meaning:

shulush (shoh-lohsh) = shoes

i (ehn) = to or for him, her, it

takchi (tahk-che) = tie

chi (chehn) = future tense marker (from **achi**)

ho (hohn) = question marker

ulla (ahl-la) = child

mut (maht) = subject marker (that/those)
