Noun: aheka – debt/bills

Aheka i pila li tuk.

I sent him a bill.

Alikchi mvt aheka a pila tuk kiyo.

That doctor did not send me a bill.

Word Meaning: **aheka** (ah-he-kah) = debt/bills

i (ehn) = to or for him, her, it

pila (peh-lah) = to send/throw **li** (lih) = I

tuk (tohk) = past tense marker

alikchi (ah-lihk-che) = doctor

mvt (maht) = subject marker (that/those)

a (ahn) = to or for me

kiyo (key-yoh) = not
