Location/Position: hik̄ia – to be standing (singular)

Miko yvt katimma hik̄ia?

Where is the chief standing?

Aimpa bilika hik̄ia.

He is standing near the table.

Word Meaning: **miko** (mehn-koh) = chief

yvt (yaht) = subject marker **aiimpa** (eye-ehm-pa) = table

katimma (kah-tim-ma) = where

hik̄ia (hih-kihn-yah) = to be standing (singular)

bilika (bih-lihn-ka) = near
