Location/Position: binohmaya – to be sitting (plural)

**Okla impa hosh binohmaya.**

They are sitting there eating.

**Ulla ushta mvt katimma binohmaya?**

Where are those four children sitting?

Word Meaning: **okla** (ohk-lah) = they/people

**impa** (ehm-pah) = eat (a meal)

**hosh** (hohsh) = subject/adverb marker

**binohmaya** (bih-noh-mahn-yah) = to be sitting (plural)

**vlla** (ahl-la) = child

**ushta** (ohsh-tah) = four

**mvt** (maht) = subject marker (that/those)

**katimma** (kah-tim-mah) = where
