Postpositions: nutaka - underneath

Chi shulush vt abinili nutaka taloha.

Your shoes are setting underneath the chair.

Aiimpa nutaka ma bohli.

Lay it underneath the table.

Word Meaning: **nutaka** (noh-tah-kah) = underneath

chi (chehn) = your (possessive pronoun)

shulush (shoh-lohsh) = shoe/ shoes

vt (aht) = subject marker **abinili** (ah-bih-nih-lih) = chair

taloha (tah-lohn-ha) = to be setting (dual)

aiimpa (eye-ehm-pa) = table **ma** (mahn) = object marker

bohli (boh-lih) = put/ place/ lay(s)

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
