

Lesson of The Day

Location/Position: takohli – to be hanging (dual)

Takkon tuklo hosh iti ma takohli.

There are two apples hanging on the tree.

Shupo chito tuklo yvt katimma takohli?

Where are the two big hats hanging?

Word Meaning: **shupo** (shah-poh) = hat

takkon (tahk-kohn) = apples **tuklo** (tohk-loh) = two

hosh (hohsh) = subject/adverb marker

iti (ih-tee) = tree **katimma** (kah-tim-ma) = where

ma (mahn) = object marker **chito** (che-toh) = big/ large

takohli (tah-kohn-lih) = to be hanging (dual)

yvt (yaht) = subject marker

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
