

Lesson of The Day

Location/Position: kahmaya – to be lying (plural)

Ofi ushta yvt nusi hosh ma kahmaya.

The four dogs are lying there sleeping.

Ulla vhleha yvt katimma kahmaya?

Where are the children lying?

Word Meaning: **ma** (mahn) = adverb

ofi (o-feh) = dog ushta (ohsh-tah) = four

yvt (yaht) = subject marker **nusi** (noh-see) = sleep

hosh (hohsh) = subject/adverb Marker

kahmaya (kah-mahn-yah) = to be lying (plural)

ulla (ahl-la) = child **vhleha** (ah-theh-ha) = plural

katimma (kah-tim-ma) = where
