Where is that dog lying?

Iti nuta ittonla.

It is lying under the tree.

Word Meaning:

ofi (o-feh) = dog

mvt (maht) = subject marker (that/those)

katimma (kah-tim-ma) = where

ittonla (iht-tohn-la) = to be lying (singular)

iti (ih-tee) = tree

nuta (noh-tah) = under
