Location/Position: kaha – to be lying (dual)

Ulla tek tuklo mvt chim aboha kaha.

Those two girls are lying in your room.

Ofosik tuklo mvt katimma kaha?

Where are those two puppies lying?

Word Meaning: **ulla tek** (ahl-la teek) = girl

tuklo (tohk-loh) = two **chim** (chehm) = your

ofosik (o-fohn-sic) = puppy

mvt (maht) = subject marker (that/those)

aboha (ah-boh-ha) = room

kaha (kahn-ha) = to be lying (dual)

katimma (kah-tim-ma) = where
