Postposition: takla – among

Ofi mvt vlla vhleha takla ittonla.

That dog is lying among the children.

Ulla mvt hattak lawa takla hikia.

That child is standing among many men.

Word Meaning: **takla** (tahnk-la) = among

ofi (o-feh) = dog **mvt** (maht) = subject marker

vlla (ahl-la) = child **lawa** (la-wah) = many

vhleha (ah-theh-ha) = plural

hattak (haht-tahk) = man

ittonla (iht-tohn-la) = to be lying (singular)

hikia (hih-kihn-yah) = to be standing (singular)

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
