Postposition: ittintv̄kla - between

Ofi lusa mvt abinili tuklo ma ittintv̄kla ittonla.

That black dog is lying between those two chairs.

Aiimpa tuklo ma ittintv̄kla bohli.

Lay it between those two tables.

Word Meaning: **ofi** (o-feh) = dog

lusa (loh-sah) = black **tuklo** (tohk-loh) = two

mvt (maht) = subject marker (that/those)

abinili (ah-bih-nih-lih) = chair

ma (mahn) = object marker

ittintv̄kla (iht-tihn-tahk-la) = between

ittonla (iht-tohn-la) = to be lying (singular)

aiimpa (eye-ehm-pa) = table

bohli (boh-lih) = put/place/lay(s)
