Postposition: misha i t^unn^vp = on that side of or opposite side

Ofosik vt kaa misha i t^unn^vp ittonla tuk.

The puppy was lying on that side of the car.

Hina misha i t^unn^vp ia li.

I am going on that side of the road.

Word Meaning: **ofosik** (o-fohn-sic) = puppy

vt (aht) = subject marker **kaa** (kah) = car

misha i t^unn^vp (meh-shaw-ehn-than-nahp) = on that side of opposite side

ittonla (iht-tohn-la) = to be lying (singular)

tuk (tohk) = past tense marker

hina (hih-nah) = road

ia (e-yah) = go/going **li** (lih) = I
