Postposition: paknaka – over/above

Holbvt toba mvt aiimpa paknaka takanli.

That picture is hanging above the table.

Chim ilefoka himona yvt abinili paknaka takohmaya.

Your new clothes are hanging over the chair.

Word Meaning: **aiimpa** (eye-ehm-pa)= table

holbvt toba (hohl-baht-toh-bah) = picture/image

mvt (maht) = subject marker (that/those)

paknaka (pahk-nah-kah) = over/above

takanli (tah-kahn-lih) = to be hanging (singular)

chim (chehm) = your **ilefoka** (ih-lih-foh-ka) = clothes

himona (he-moh-na) = new **yvt** (yaht) = subject marker

abinili (ah-bihi-nih-lih) = chair

takohmaya (tah-koh-mahn-yah) = to be hanging (plural)

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
