

Lesson of The Day

The previous lesson stated, “**Chi afama li kv̄t sv̄ na yukpa.**” (I am happy to meet you.) Today’s lesson is a response to that statement.

Ūno akia, chi afama li kv̄t sv̄ na yukpa.

I am happy to meet you as well.

Word Meaning: **ūno** (ah-noh) = as for myself

chi (che) = you

akia (a-ke-ya) = also

afama (ah-fah-ma) = ‘to meet’

kv̄t (kaht) = subject marker

sv̄ (sah) = I am

li (le) = I

na yukpa (na yohk-pa) = happy

Note: Sometimes Choctaw words do not match up verbatim with English, however, the content of the Choctaw meaning will be close to the English translation.
