Possessive Adjectives: hvchimmi – yours/belongs to you (all)

Aiimpa tuklo pvt hvchimmi yo?

Are these two tables yours?

Ofosik mvt hvchimmi kiyo.

That puppy does not belong to you all.

Word Meaning: **ofosik** (o-fohn-sic) = puppy

aiimpa (eye-ehm-pa) = table

tuklo (tohk-loh) = two **kiyo** (key-yoh) = not

mvt (maht) = that/those (short for yvmmvt)

hvpimmi (ha-pihm-mih) = ours/belongs to us (all)

pvt (paht) = this/these (short for ilvppvt)

yo (yohn) = question marker
