Chahta anumpa anumpli la hinla.

I can speak Choctaw.

Chahta anumpa anumpli la he kiyo.

I cannot speak Choctaw.

Word Meaning:

Chahta (Chah-tah) = Choctaw

anumpa (ah-nohm-pa) = word/language.

anumpli (ah-nohm-poh-lih) = speak/talk

la (la) = I (*li* changes to *la* to take the ‘a’ from the following word)

ahinla (hihn-la) = can/may (see explanation above)

he kiyo (he-key-yoh) = cannot
